



MBIA Employees Mark 10th Anniversary of 9/11 Attacks with a Company-Wide Volunteer Program

Flag Tribute to be Installed on Company Lawn

On Friday, September 9, MBIA will join individuals and corporations across the nation in commemorating the 10th anniversary of the 9/11 attacks through participation in the National Day of Service and Remembrance. The Company is actively encouraging its over 300 employees in the tri-state area to choose from volunteer projects planned at 12 local non-profits, including the American Legion Auxiliary in Valhalla; Hilltop Hanover Farm in Yorktown; Food Bank for Westchester in Millwood; Leake and Watts in Yonkers; Connecticut Habitat for Humanity in Stamford and Bridgeport and the Community Food Bank of New Jersey in Hillside.

Several volunteer projects are also planned on MBIA's Armonk campus, including a Flag Tribute, where employees will position on the company lawn one flag for each of the 2,977 men, women and children who died in the attacks of September 11, 2001. The tribute will remain standing until Tuesday, September 13.

MBIA's third annual participation in the 9/11 Day of Service and Remembrance is sponsored and was organized by the MBIA Foundation, which has supported worthy charitable organizations in the tri-state area since 2001. "With so many who perished being in the financial services industry, we feel a particular connection to the victims of the attacks against America," said Willard Hill, Jr., President of the MBIA Foundation. "We believe the flag display is a fitting tribute to those who died that day. Our participation in the National Day of Service also supports the MBIA Foundation's goal of facilitating volunteerism among employees, and allows us to learn about, and form bonds with, the many worthwhile organizations in our area."
